Personal Social and emotional development

This half term we will develop our understanding about making the right choices and being a good friend. Our teachers will be looking out for good sharing and good playing while we are at Nursery! We will work on developing our independence by accessing activities ourselves and making sure we tidy them away when we have finished!

Physical Development

We will have lots of opportunities to develop our gross (large) and fine (small) motor skills. Our teachers have been encouraging us to have a go at doing our own coats which we are getting really good at now! We will continue to practise putting them on ourselves and pulling up our zips. We will also practise our scissor skills when doing craft activities at Nursery. Our teachers will encourage us to develop an effective pencil grip when mark making. We will play games in small groups aimed at developing our balance and co ordination and will develop our fine motor skills in dough disco!

Literacy

This half term our topics are Winter stories and Nursery Rhymes. We will be looking at the changes to our environment in winter and exploring our outdoor area. We will be reading the stories The Very Hungry Caterpillar, Dear Zoo and The Tiger who came to Tea. Our teachers will ask us questions about the story to see what we can remember. We will be reading stories and non fiction books linked to the Nursery Rhymes that we are learning. We will also be focusing on the elements from Phase One, 'Letters and Sounds' which will help ensure we are ready and able to become successful when reading and writing. Some children will start to learn their letter sounds through our RWI scheme. We will continue to self register in the morning and see if we can recognise our names without our picture on! Our teachers will also help us to practise writing our names!

Communication and language

This half term we will spending time in small groups linked to our topics on Winter stories and Nursery Rhymes. We will practise sitting and listening in small groups and play games which will develop our ability to answer and also ask questions. We will sing lots of Nursery rhymes together and talk about the words that rhyme.

Exploring Arts and design

We will have lots of opportunities to be creative this half term in Nursery. Our teachers will be adding materials to the playdough and paint for us to develop our imagination! We will be exploring winter through marble and ice paintings and make paper plate polar bears!

Understanding the world

We will be doing lots of exploring the world around us through our topics this half term. We will be looking at eggs and where they come from and exploring the outdoor areas and we will need wellie boots for when we go on our bear hunt! We will also use the interactive whiteboard and I-pads to support our learning.

Maths

We have been working so hard on our counting skills in Nursery. This half term we are continuing to learn our numbers through the Tentown scheme. We will sing lots of counting songs which will help us to say the numbers in the right order and play counting games that involve us splitting a group of objects in different ways. We will practise matching sets of objects to the numbers that we have been learning and have opportunities to explore a range of shape activities linked to our topics!
