

## Nursery home learning 18/05/20 – Five Minutes' Peace

### Questions to discuss-

- Encourage your child to talk about their favourite parts.
- Why is that your favourite part?
- What did Mrs Large want and why?
- How many children did Mrs Large have?
- What did Lester want to show his mom?
- Why do you think Mrs Large wanted five minutes peace?
- What was Mrs Large looking forward to eat and drink?
- Did Mrs Large eat her slice of cake?
- How do you think Mrs Large felt when the children jumped into the bath?
- How would you describe Mrs Large?
- How do you think Mrs Large felt when she went back downstairs?

### Activities

- Have a go at some of the counting activities on top marks.

- Learn about telling the time. Use a clock or timer to time different lengths of time. Start with 1 minute and see how many challenges you can complete within the time limit.
- Make and decorate some cupcakes or biscuits. Can they follow the recipe and talk about the steps of the recipe and how the ingredients change when they are baked. Eat them as a snack just like Mrs Large wanted to in the story!
- Can you write a list of ingredients you will need to make cupcakes or why not write about your favourite part or your favourite character.
- Create a bath for Mrs Large using a tray of water and add some bubbles. Are there any toys that may need cleaning using a brush or sponge.
- Memory game, can you remember all the items on Mrs Large's tray? Why not make your own memory game and put five items together and get someone to take one away and see if you can remember the item they have removed.
- Using some recycling items see if you can make your own elephant or an elephant mask.
  - What colour do you need?
  - Can you remember how we can make that colour?
