### Questions to discuss-

- Encourage your child to talk about their favourite parts of the story.
- Why is that your favourite part?
- What was each house made out of?
- Can you describe the different materials used to make each house?
- How do you think the pigs felt when the wolf knocked on their doors?
- What house would you choose to make?
- Why do you think the wolf couldn't blow the brick house down?
- Where do you think the first and the second pig will live now?
- Why do you think the wolf was knocking on the little pigs doors?
- How do you think Mrs Pig felt when the three little pigs left?

### Activities

- Have a go at 'I Spy counting'. Can you write the amount of each picture correctly.
- Can you write an invitation to mommy pig, inviting her to come to tea.
- Watch ten town number 9, you should have been given the log in details previously.
- Practise writing the number 9. You can make a number 9 using leaves or items from around the house or outdoor area.
- Can you find 9 of the same items (toilet rolls), can you count 9 different items (beans, spaghetti, soup cans).
- Continue to practise writing your name.
- Can you have a go at making your own house out of any recycling materials you might have.
- Have a go at exercising and catch a pig by following the link below.
