## What is continuous provision?

Continuous provision is a time when children complete activities suggested by us AS WELL as choosing things that they are interested in themselves. PLEASE remember that at school we encourage children to play and explore their own ideas during the day- this IS learning through play and is a really important part of their development. At home if your child has completed the challenge, PLEASE give them time to play with their own toys, resources etc such as construction, books, role play, dolls, painting, cooking, etc. This is so important in ensuring that children maintain a love of learning.
