	Children will be able to.....
Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Link sounds to letters for set 1 sounds and know which sound each letter makes (RWI online support)• Use their phonic knowledge to blend sounds together to read words (challenge is dependent on their phonics group)• Recognise a selection of tricky/common irregular words when reading (10 as a minimum)• Listen to and share ideas about a story that they have read as well as answer simple questions
Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Link set 1 sounds to letters and know which sound each letter makes when writing (RWI online support)• Use their phonic knowledge to segment sounds when writing words (challenge dependent on phonics group)• Spell at least 5 tricky/common irregular words correctly• Apply their phonic knowledge when writing words in a simple sentence• Begin to read back the sentence they have written
Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Count out up to 20 objects carefully (support from Oak National academy and WRM)• Order numbers to 20• Say what one more or one less that a number is• Add and subtract two single-digit numbers• Begin to solve problems involving doubling, halving and sharing• Begin to recognise, recreate and describe patterns• Begin to name and describe shapes
