How many arms., legs, eyes etc will he have?</p> <p>Ask a grown up or brother or sister o draw one too- are they similar, different? How? Can you give yours a name and write it next to them?</p>	<p>Talk to a grown up about your robot.</p> <p>Write a sentence about your robot from yesterday using your sounds- eg my robot has a pink head.</p> <p>My robot is helpful. My robot is called.....</p>	<p>Collect <b>different cereal boxes, biscuit empty food boxes or use anything you have around the house to build a robot- can you send a photograph to us on Seesaw? Maybe you can describe him in a video ie he has a cuboid shaped head, long round arms etc.</b></p>	<p>In the story, Nobot uses his robot bottom for lots of different things ie a birds nest, drums and a hat. What else could Nobot use his bottom for? Can you draw a picture and write a sentence about it? ie He could use his bottom as a.....</p> <p>(don't forget to use your sounds, don't worry about spelling every word correctly!)</p>

Extra Challenge	<p><b>Create your own story jars</b> Get three jars/boxes. Write or draw random prompts on bits of paper. For example, some animals in jar one, pieces of clothing in jar two and extra items (instruments, vehicles, tools, etc.) in jar three. Each day, take a prompt from each jar and create a drawing or story which includes all three items, e.g. a cat wearing sun glasses playing a saxophone.</p>	<p><b>Memory game</b> Close your eyes, then someone moves something in the room. Can you tell what it is? Extra fun if you use the whole house.</p>	<p><b>Treasure Hunt</b> Make a list for someone else in your home. Can they find these items in your home? Can you make something using these items?</p>	<p><b>Be the Star of the Show</b> Put on a show for your family. You could make up a story to tell everyone, sing your favourite songs or perform a dance.</p>	<p><b>Make a Family Tree</b> Either just on screen/paper or go 3D! Add photos and stories about each person.</p>
