Number blocks challenge	<p><b>1 less than...</b></p> <p>Watch this episode  <a href="https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episode/b08phr1g/numberblocks-series-2-ten">https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episode/b08phr1g/numberblocks-series-2-ten</a></p> <p>Can you play this game with an adult:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Get 10 different objects</li> <li>• Ask your grown up to close their eyes as you take an object away.</li> <li>• Ask them to open their eyes- what have you taken away? Can they tell you what is missing? How many objects are there now?</li> <li>• Repeat this, but as a challenge take MORE than 1 object away- can they work out how many are missing? Then repeat with different amounts</li> <li>• Can you draw some of the ways that you have shared your objects between the 2 spaceships just like in the episode you watched? <b>Send it to Seesaw for us to see!</b></li> </ul>	<p><b>Ways of making 10</b></p> <p>Watch the episode again from yesterday; can you remember any of the different ways to make 10?
