Maths

In maths this half term, we will be continuing our work on measures linked to length, weight and capacity. We will also be looking at multiplication facts. By the end of year 2 children should securely know their 2, 5, 10 and 3 times table. As well as this we will be looking at fractions. All of the topics covered at taught begin with the children using practical resources and when confident moving on to pectoral and then just symbols.

Key maths vocabulary

Measurement vocabulary—weight /mass kg g capacity ml I / length mm cm m. Fraction a whole part of a whole half quarter equal equivalent. Numbers 1-100, hundreds, partition, recombine, hundred more, hundred less, size, bigger, larger, smaller, pattern, different.

Reading & Writing
