



Heathlands Primary Academy PE & Sports Premium

Timescale	Sports Grant funding
September 2016 - July 2017	£9,800

Purpose of funding:

The Government has provided funding to all primary schools to help improve the quality of PE & Sport for all pupils. The premium must be used to fund additional and sustainable improvements to the provision of PE and sport, for the benefit of primary-aged pupils, in the 2016 to 2017 academic year, to encourage the development of healthy, active lifestyles.

Calculation of funding:

Allocations for the academic year 2016 to 2017 are calculated using the number of pupils in years 1 to 6, as recorded in the January 2016 census, as follows:

- schools with 17 or more pupils receive £8,000 plus £5 per pupil
- schools with 16 or fewer pupils receive £500 per pupil

How we have used the funding:

The funding helps towards the cost of purchasing services from 'Evolve' – a Sports coach is in school for 4 full days per week (Tuesday to Friday) for the whole academic year (September 2016 – July 2017).

The sports coach works alongside staff to provide PE sessions to pupils throughout the school from Nursery to Year 6. The coach is an excellent role model for the children and supports the Curriculum PE lessons, lunchtime sessions and afterschool clubs.

PE Provision:

The range of activities during the day:

- PE provision for all year groups
- Nurture groups – working with Year 6 pupils who have been identified as requiring additional support with social skills, friendship, respect, behaviour management & self-esteem
- Lunchtime clubs – runs inclusive football & cricket sessions for selected Y5 & Y6 pupils
- **FREE** after school clubs – multi-sports for Years 2 – 6 (includes athletics, basket-ball, football, cricket, rounders, bench ball, dodge ball)
- Arranges football matches with local school teams for boys & girls
- Weekly football practice
- Organised Sport's Day
- Liaises with Learning Mentor Pastoral team to provide additional support to encourage pupil participation

Impact:

- Provides all the pupils with a variety of sports from a professional coach which develops the pupil's knowledge & skills
- Encourages the pupils to have a healthier lifestyle & undertake regular activity
- Increases confidence of pupils
- Enables the Academy to provide a broader range of activities for the children
- Increased participation of competitive sport
- Improves a variety of sporting opportunities for all pupils
- Pupils are stimulated & challenged
- Raises the profile of PE and sport
- Provides CPD for staff to develop their knowledge and skills of teaching PE & Sport
